

Adding Content to Your Course (Modules)

- 1.) Modules are another word for units. So let's add units to your class. From the navigation bar choose modules. As you notice some of the content is light gray and others are dark. You can still add content to the light gray topics. Course modules let you organize your assignments, pages, files, etc. into smaller sections or units. Modules could be centered on a theme, focused on a specific topic, or even just grouped chronologically.

You can also sequence modules by defining criteria and prerequisites for each module. Students won't be able to access modules until they have unlocked all their prerequisites. That way you can prevent students from accessing certain content or files until they have, say, gotten at least 75% on a review quiz.

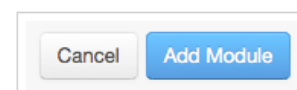
- 2.) Click
